

Proposal for Spain Trip

Destination:	Spain, Madrid and Barcelona
Dates:	April 13-21, 2012 <i>April vacation is April 14-22</i>
Educational Rationale:	This is a unique opportunity for students studying Spanish to visit Spain and be immersed in the language they have been studying throughout their high school career. The students will experience first hand the culture of Spain through visits to historical sites, shows, and museums. As part of the educational component of the trip, the students will have to prepare a lesson for the group about one of the historical or cultural sites that they will visit and they will present to the group. Another aspect of the trip is a visit a local school to interact with students.
Number of participants:	20-25 (Students must be enrolled in Spanish 4, Spanish 4 Honors, Spanish 5 or AP Spanish.)
Trip Leader:	Trip leader: Adrienne Talamas Additional chaperones: 2
Itinerary:	The group will fly to Madrid where they will stay for 4 nights. There will be day trips from Madrid to Segovia and Avila. The students will then travel by motor coach to Barcelona where they will stay for 3 nights.
Projected Costs:	The trip is being organized by World Cultural Tours in Uxbridge, MA. The price includes flights, land transportation, food, lodging, entrance fees, and the cost of the chaperones. Estimated cost: \$2,550
