To Members of the Belmont School Committee and School Administration:

The Student Care Programs would like to provide you with some information about each of our Programs. It should be useful as we go forward looking at the issues of rent, space, and other areas of mutual concern.

We think it would benefit all to know what the rent is all about. Is the school system mainly trying to cover its costs to have us in the building (electricity, water, basic bathroom supplies, administrative costs, general wear and tear), or is it something else?

We feel that space usage can be a difficult basis for configuring rent. The spaces at the various schools are obviously not the same and they can change from year to year, or month to month. The other consideration is what constitutes a room that rent is charged for? How do you compare a cafeteria to a classroom? Two classrooms isn't any more space than the cafeteria or the gym, but would be twice the rental as it is computed now.

The Directors of the five Programs in town have been talking about alternate ways to more fairly apportion the fees collected from the Programs. We talked about tying the fees to the number of kids in each Program (too fluid especially in these difficult financial times); space usage by the square foot (no one cared for this one and again it can change); etc. One other option we talked about was more along the line of a user fee. We all provide much the same types of activities and services to the children and families of Belmont. We do vary somewhat by size but not hugely.

The cost to have these Programs in each school is probably quite equitable, but the costs to the individual Programs are all over the place. We feel there should be parity between the schools and the sections of Belmont that they service. Why does it cost one school \$28,800.00 to have a childcare program and another \$7,200.00?

We look forward to meeting with you and discussing our thoughts.
