

Proposal for Latin Trip

- Destination:** Italy
- Dates:** April 13-24, 2011
- Educational rationale:** This is a unique opportunity for students studying Latin to visit in *situ* Roman buildings, ruins, and art. In addition, students will view and discuss the Renaissance period, making the connection to their studies of European history and literature. As part of the educational requirement for the trip, participants are required to act as "guides" and prepare (before leaving) two different oral presentations: one on the ruins of a building in the Forum and another on a classical work of art.
- Number of participants:** 40
(Students must have completed or be enrolled in Latin IV honors or AP Latin.)
- Trip Leader:** Trip leader: Brian Dunn
Additional chaperones: 3
- Itinerary:** The group will fly to Rome and stay in Rome for 5 nights. Then the group will travel to Sorrento by motor coach and stay in the town of Sorrento for 5 nights, returning to Rome for departure. (The daily itinerary is attached.)
- Projected Costs:** The trip is being organized by World Cultural Tours in Uxbridge, MA. The price includes flights, excursions, entrance fees, food, lodging, and the cost of the chaperones. Estimated cost: \$2,800.
