This year, almost 12,000 works of art were submitted for adjudication by over 6,000 Massachusetts secondary school (middle and high school) students, of which 3,381 pieces of art received awards. Of the 193 paintings and drawings that received gold keys, fourteen were received by Belmont High School students. Across all categories, 562 works were designated Gold Key; nineteen were received by Belmont students.

Students' art work that has been designated as Gold Key and Silver Key will be on exhibit at the Massachusetts State Transportation Building in Boston from February 14 – April 7, 2011. The students will be honored at a reception which will be held at the John Hancock Hall on Sunday, March 6, 2011.

This is only one measure of high performance achieved by Belmont students in the visual art, and is a clear indication of a strong and sequential curriculum taught by a highly qualified staff that begins in Kindergarten.
