Mr. DiCologero gave an explanation of the Leadership Council's recommendations regarding various fees in FY12. Increases were recommended for F-1 Visa Student Tuition, Full Day Kindergarten Tuition, Preschool Tuition, and Busing.

On a motion offered by Mr. Scharfman and seconded by Ms. Vose, it was

**VOTED** unamimously (6-0) to set the fee for tuition for F-1 visa students to automatically adjust annually to match the most current per pupil expenditure rate for the Belmont Public Schools.
