# Dear Wellington Families,

Every year in the month of February Wellington students in grades 2-4 take part in an event called Jump Rope for Heart. This event is sponsored by the American Heart Association. During this unit, our students learn about how to keep their hearts healthy through cardiovascular endurance and proper nutrition. We work on a variety of jump rope skills in class, and raise money for the American Heart Association outside of class.

We offered a class prize this year to the classroom that had the most students participate in fundraising. The winning class is Ms. Ebdon's  $2^{nd}$  grade class, and they will be receiving an extra recess session as their prize. This year our school raised more money than we ever

# Incoming Kindergarteners:

Do you or someone you know have a kindergartener planning to come to Wellington next school year? If the answer is YES, we need your help in getting the word out about registration, Information Night, and Intake Screening Day.

- <u>Registration</u>: This year ALL registration must be completed, *prior* to April 3. Go to the Belmont Public Schools website to begin this process. Begin registration online. Once you have completed the online forms, bring required documents to the office (as outlined in the directions from the website). We will complete your registration at that point and also sign you up for the Intake Screening Day.
- Information Night: Parents and guardians are invited to attend the Wellington Information Night on Thursday, March 30 at 5:30PM. You will meet the kindergarten teachers and hear critical information about how to prepare of a successful kindergarten year. This is for parents/guardians only, and not for children. (Thank you!)
- Intake Screening Day: \* You must have a completed file and you must make an hour-long appointment to participate in this event on Thursday, April 27. Creating this appointment happens on the day when you bring your documents to the school, as outlined above. \* You MUST bring your incoming Kindergartener to this event!

# 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade MCAS Testing:

As noted in our calendar above, MCAS testing is upon us. We will be testing third graders using the paper-based test so there are no changes to our implementation processes. Third grade students will all be tested at the same time on the five days listed above, as they have been in the past. The State Department of Elementary and Secondary Education mandated that all fourth graders be tested using computers. This mandate protracts the testing window for fourth grade. Specifically, fourth graders have the same number of days of testing (5) but, because we can only test ONE class a day in our computer lab, each teacher has different days within the window for his/her tests. *Each fourth grade teacher will be sending parents and quardians their unique testing schedules by the end of next week*.

## Outstanding Teacher Awards (FBE):

As you may have seen, the announcement for the 2017 Outstanding Teacher Awards went out on the district list-serve last week. The nomination period for this event runs through March 31<sup>st</sup>. The Foundation for Belmont Education is excited to announce the 2017 Outstanding Teacher Awards. This program recognizes and celebrates the extraordinary contributions made by teachers in the Belmont Public Schools.

Nominations are currently being accepted for these awards. Belmont parents and community members, Belmont Public School colleagues, and high school or middle school students can submit nominations for teachers - of any grade, subject, or specialty - who they feel deserve this special recognition.

Teachers from Belmont's six schools are chosen for this award. Each award winner will be honored at a surprise celebration at their school and at a district-wide awards ceremony to be held on May 2nd at the Chenery Middle School.

#### **GREEN TEAM NEWS!**

The Wellington PTO Green Committee is committed to helping our school reduce waste in the cafeteria. You'll be hearing more from us about that. For now, here are some 'Astonishing Facts' about food waste:

- 1. In the US, wasted food contributes 33 million tons of trash to landfills, where it proceeds to decompose, producing 25 percent of U.S. methane emissions. This contributes to global warming.
- 2. Only the best-looking produce makes it to the supermarket, meaning entire crops of perfectly edible fruit and vegetables are discarded because they do not meet exacting marketing standards for their physical characteristics.
- 3. In the U.S., wasted food costs \$165 billion per year (more than \$40 billion from household waste). Of that, \$750 million per year is spent just to dispose of the food we carelessly toss in the trash.

What is the "Fourth-Grade Send-Off"? The Fourth-Grade Send-Off (4GSO) is an annual tradition at Wellington. It is a party held just for the fourth graders and their parents/guardians to celebrate the end of the students' time in elementary school and the transition to middle school. The event includes a dinner for the fourth graders (and light fare for the grown-ups), music, a slideshow, and special presentations by Principal Spangler and others. In addition, the fourth graders receive a special memory book, t-shirt, and other mementos from their time at Wellington. Due to space constraints, each student may be accompanied by up to two adults- no younger siblings please!

**When is it?** Thursday, June 15 from 6:00-8:00 pm in the Wellington cafeteria and gymnasium. Look for an Evite to come soon!

Who puts the Fourth-Grade Send-Off together? A committee of fourth-grade parents is already hard at work planning and fundraising for this special event, but third-grade parents traditionally volunteer at the party itself so we can enjoy the time with our children. Note that the event and mementos for the students are entirely self-funded

through parent donations and fundraising activities – we do not receive any funding from the school or the Wellington PTO for the Fourth-Grade Send-Off.
