# HOW TO REGISTER

- STEP 1 Refer to the class descriptions below for class content, <u>grade</u> <u>restrictions</u>, and <u>specific dates</u> for each class. Some classes may have irregular start and/or end dates.
- STEP 2 Starting **12:00AM Monday, March 27**<sup>th</sup>, complete <u>one online registration form</u> <u>per student</u>. Sign-ups for multiple classes can go on one registration form. The link to this online form is found at: http://www.belmont.k12.ma.us/winnbrook/pta/index.asp?pageID=8.
- STEP 3 Print out the registration email received for each student. We are requesting this printed record for our use in verifying online registration entries. If you do not receive a registration email after you have registered, please email us at winnbrookptaextra@gmail.com with student name(s) and approximate time of registration.
- STEP 4 After receiving an enrollment confirmation in the form of a **CLASS WELCOME EMAIL**, make payment by check payable to **Winn Brook PTA**. <u>Write student's</u> <u>name on the check and enclose check with registration email in an</u> <u>envelope labeled "PTA Extracurricular"</u>. Return this to your oldest child's teacher via homework folders or drop it off in the **RED** Extracurricular bin located in the front lobby by **Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>**.
- STEP 5 If you are registering multiple students: Enclose <u>ONE CHECK</u> and all registration emails in <u>ONE ENVELOPE</u>. Please write <u>children's name on the check</u>.

#### **REGISTRATION NOTES**

- Enrollment is for Winn Brook students only. This includes half-day kindergarteners.
- Registration is first-come, first-served. If a class is full, you will be notified that you have been waitlisted and have the option to select an alternate class.
- The online registration system will be available throughout the registration week and will be shut off after the registration deadline.
- Late registrations will be accepted only for classes not filled by the regular enrollment deadline.
- The enrollment fee will be returned if there is insufficient enrollment or over-enrollment.
- Financial support is available from the PTA. Contact program director listed below for more information.
- If your child has any special needs or restrictions, please let us know so we can inform the extracurricular instructor.
- Please be aware that there is no nurse on duty to monitor students with healthcare issues.

## **CLASS CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT**

Classroom teachers and monitors are provided with a list of children participating in Extracurricular Program classes, but it is the child's responsibility to report to class (with the exception of kindergarteners, who will always be escorted). Attendance will be taken, and a monitor will call the primary contact number listed on the registration form if a child does not report to class and is not on the list of absent children from the office. However, the monitor is not responsible for tracking missing children; they will leave a message at the primary contact number only. If your child will be in school, but not attending extracurricular class on a given day, **please email the monitors** at **winnbrookptaextra.monitors@gmail.com**.

#### Please note the following check-out procedures:

- <u>If you elect to pick up your child</u>, you must wait for him/her **in the main lobby**. Enter the school building through the front door (which will be locked; knock for the monitor to open it).
- <u>If you prefer to have your child walk</u>, or meet you outside the school building, you must choose the "Walk Home" option. Monitors will not be responsible for children whose registration forms indicate they will be walking home.

Extracurricular Program instructors are not responsible for children once their class has ended. Please make certain that your child knows his/her arrangements for getting home or to after-school care.

Monitors and instructors are not available after-hours, so **PLEASE BE PROMPT** at pickup. All children who are not picked up at class end times will wait with the monitor until they are picked up. A fee for late pick-ups will be actively enforced, with a **\$5.00 fine** for the first **10 minutes** and a **\$5.00 fine** for **every five minutes thereafter**.

## **CLASS CANCELLATIONS**

Please be sure to provide us with an email address that you can check easily on the days your child is in an extracurricular class.

We will **notify** parents of class cancellations **by email** as early as possible. If the school is closed due to snow, extracurricular classes will be cancelled and parents will not be notified separately. Students will be notified of class cancellations prior to school dismissal.

If any classes are cancelled during this session, make-ups will occur during the pre-scheduled make-up weeks.
