

Proposal for BHS Chorus Trip – April 2019

Destination: Ireland (Dublin, Galway, Limerick)

Dates: April 12-19, 2019 (April Vacation, departing on the Friday before break)

Educational Rationale: Performance tours abroad give our students the opportunity to share in the experience of travelling and performing in much the same way that a professional ensemble would. Students will have the chance to perform for foreign audiences and present their work, and they will have ample opportunities to study the rich musical and artistic cultures and traditions that exist in Ireland.

Number of participants: 40-80 students, 1 faculty chaperone per 10 students

Trip Leaders: Sean Landers (BHS Chorus Director), Arto Asadoorian (VPA Director)

Projected Costs: \$2,699-2,849 per student (double hotel occupancy)

Final cost is dependent on the number of travelers and airfare rates at the time of booking. This trip is being operated by World Cultural Tours (Uxbridge, MA), which has been the primary tour company used for international travel at BHS for the past several years. The estimated cost is inclusive of airfare, hotel, ground transportation, admission to any museums and performances, as well as breakfast and dinner each day and some lunches. It includes estimated air taxes and fuel surcharges up to \$350.
