We had 1,597 responses, representing the experiences of

- 735 students in grades preK-4
- 536 students in grades 5-8
- 325 students in grades 9-12

Note: one respondent did not select a grade level.

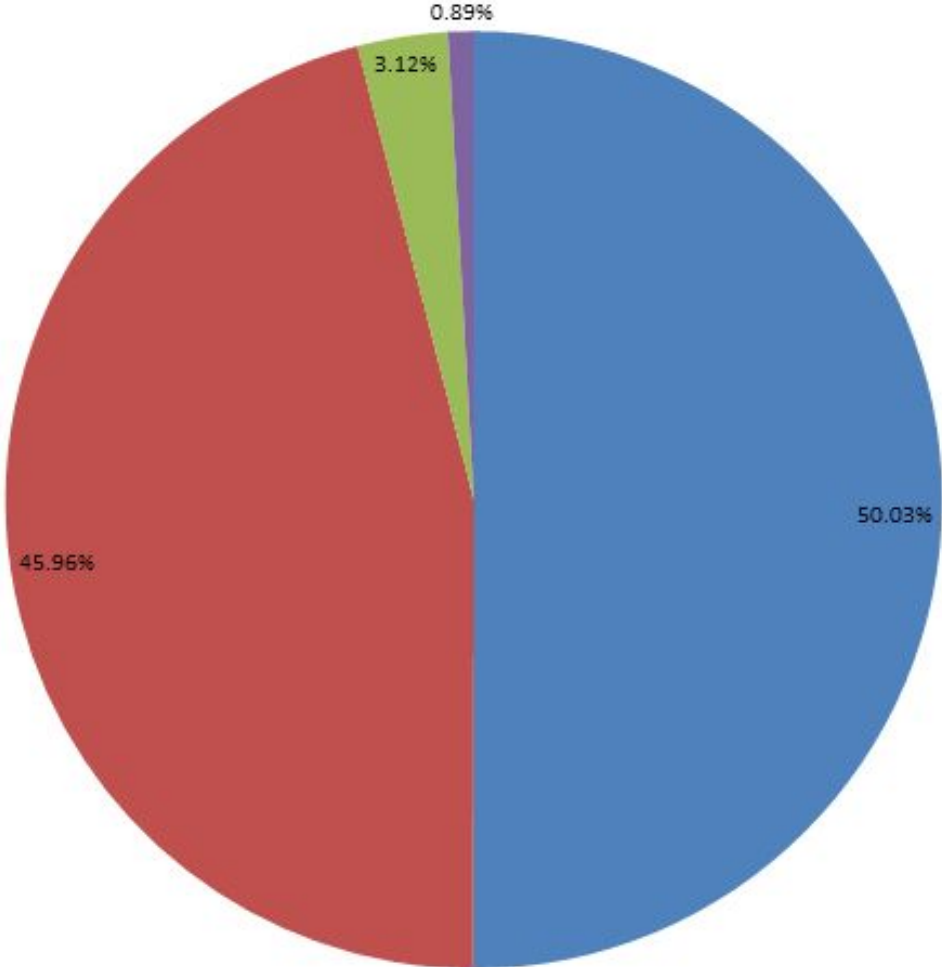

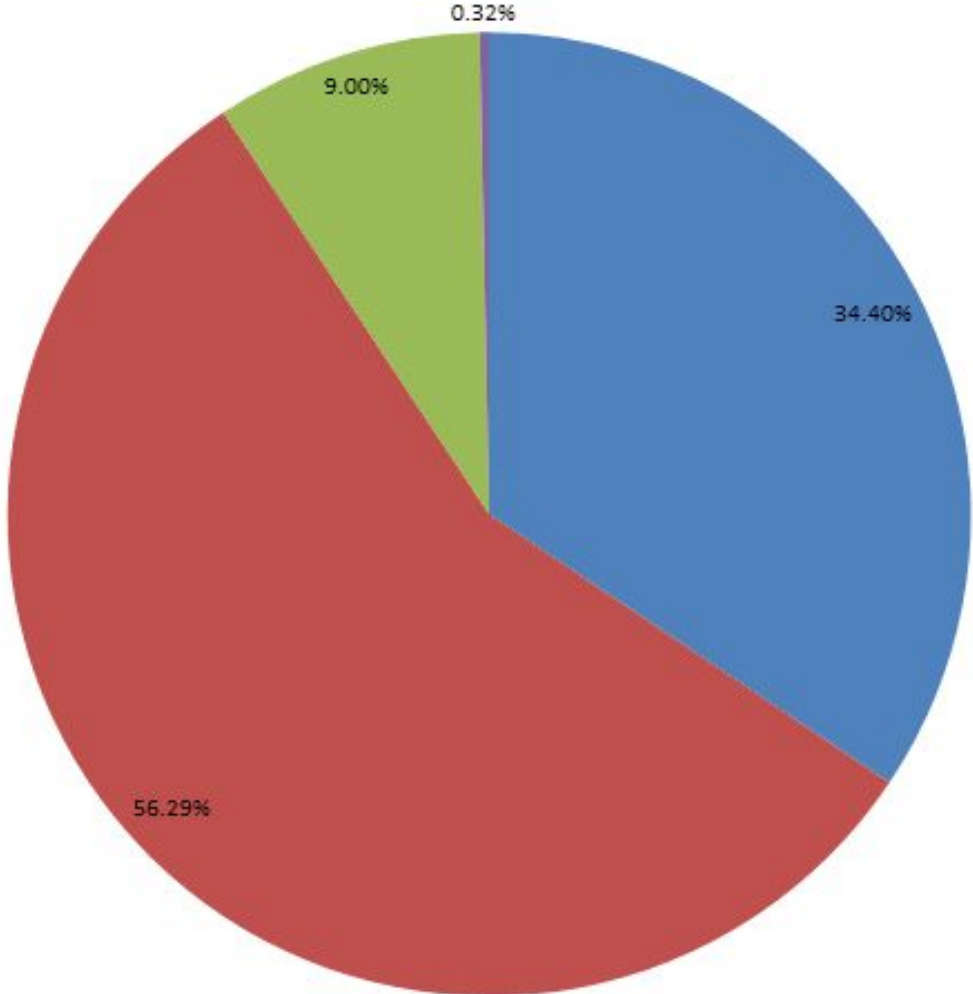

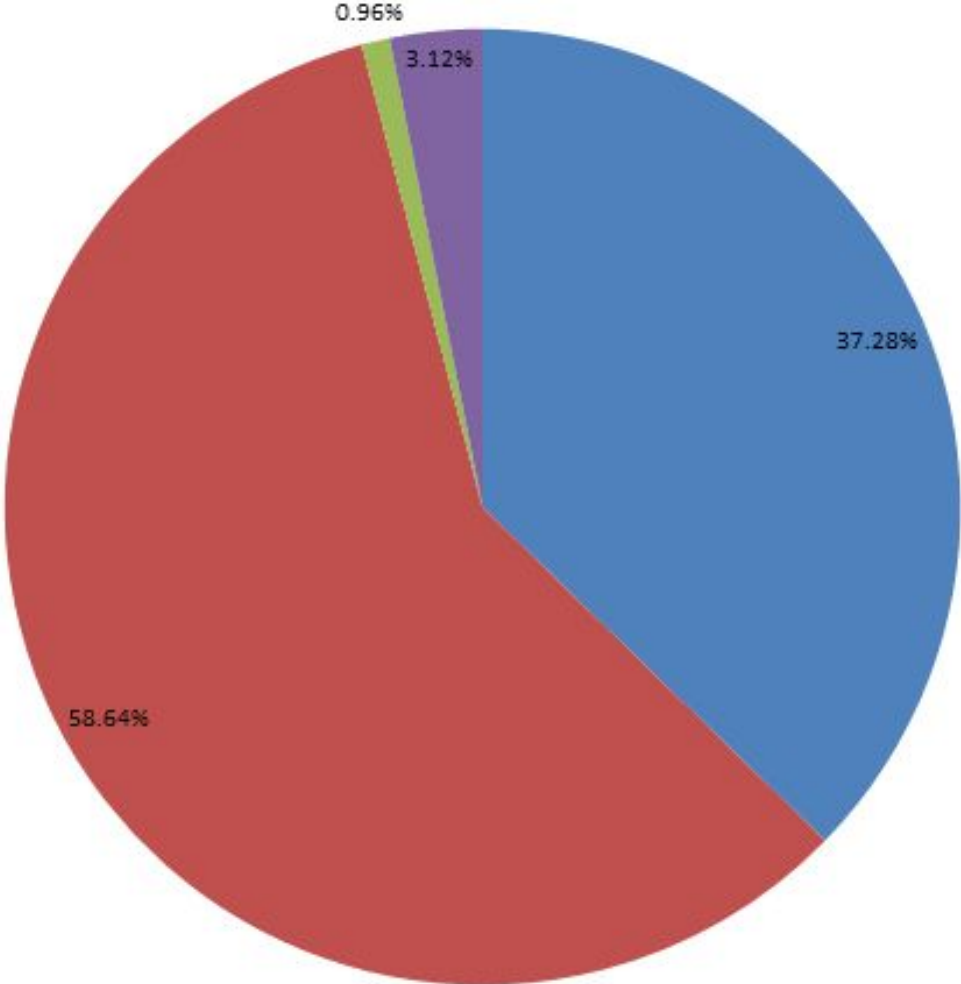
The daily or weekly structure for required learning activities

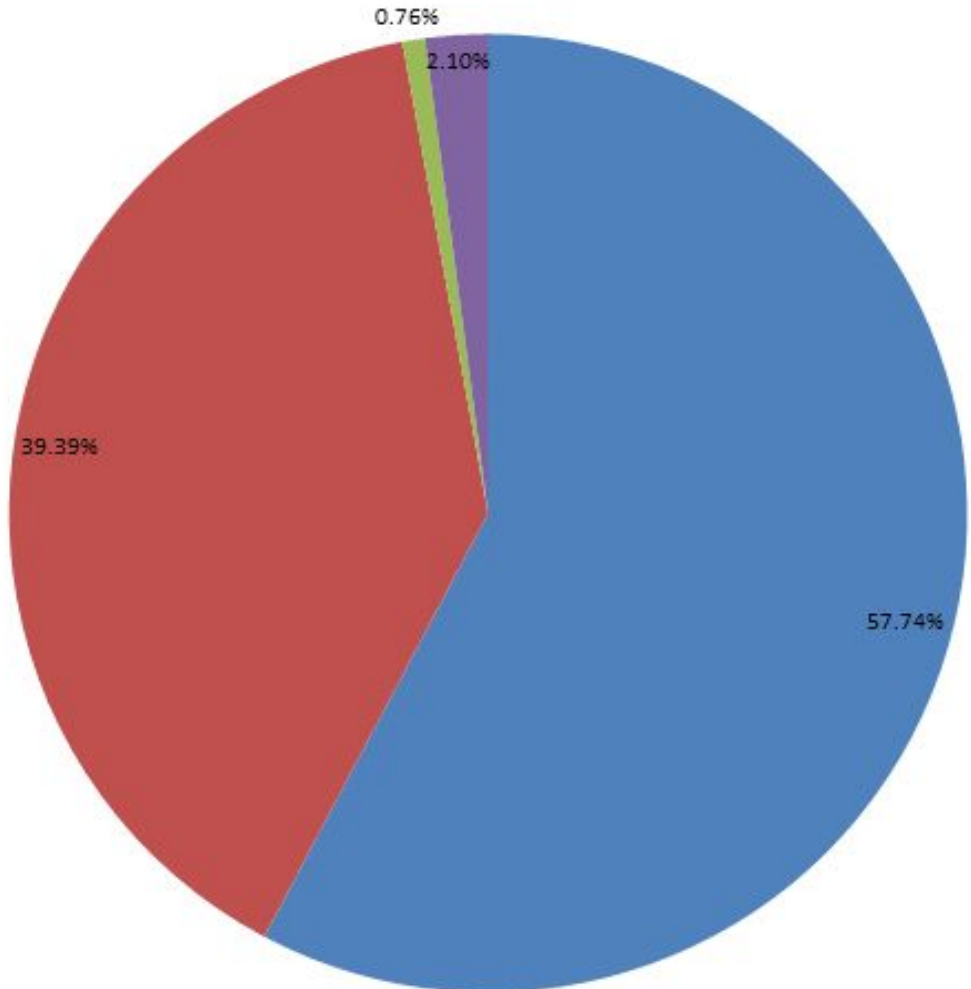

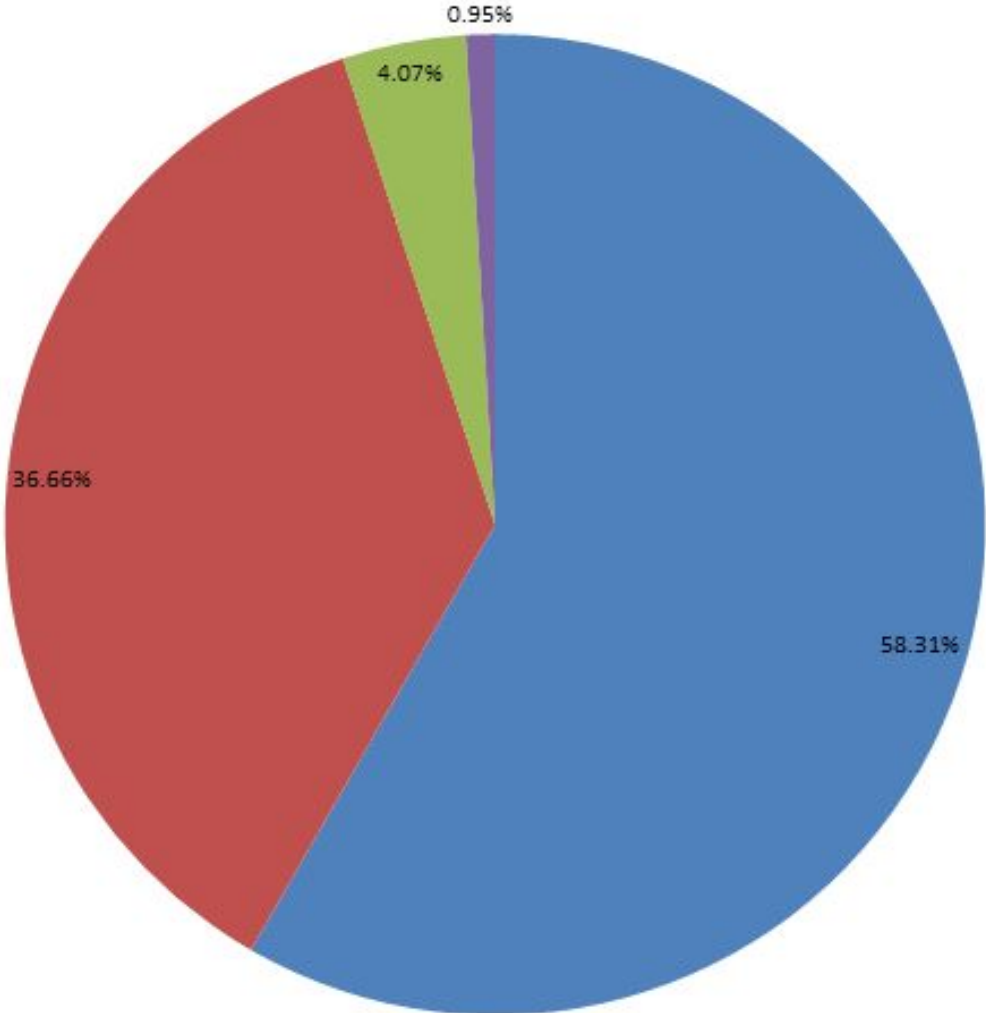

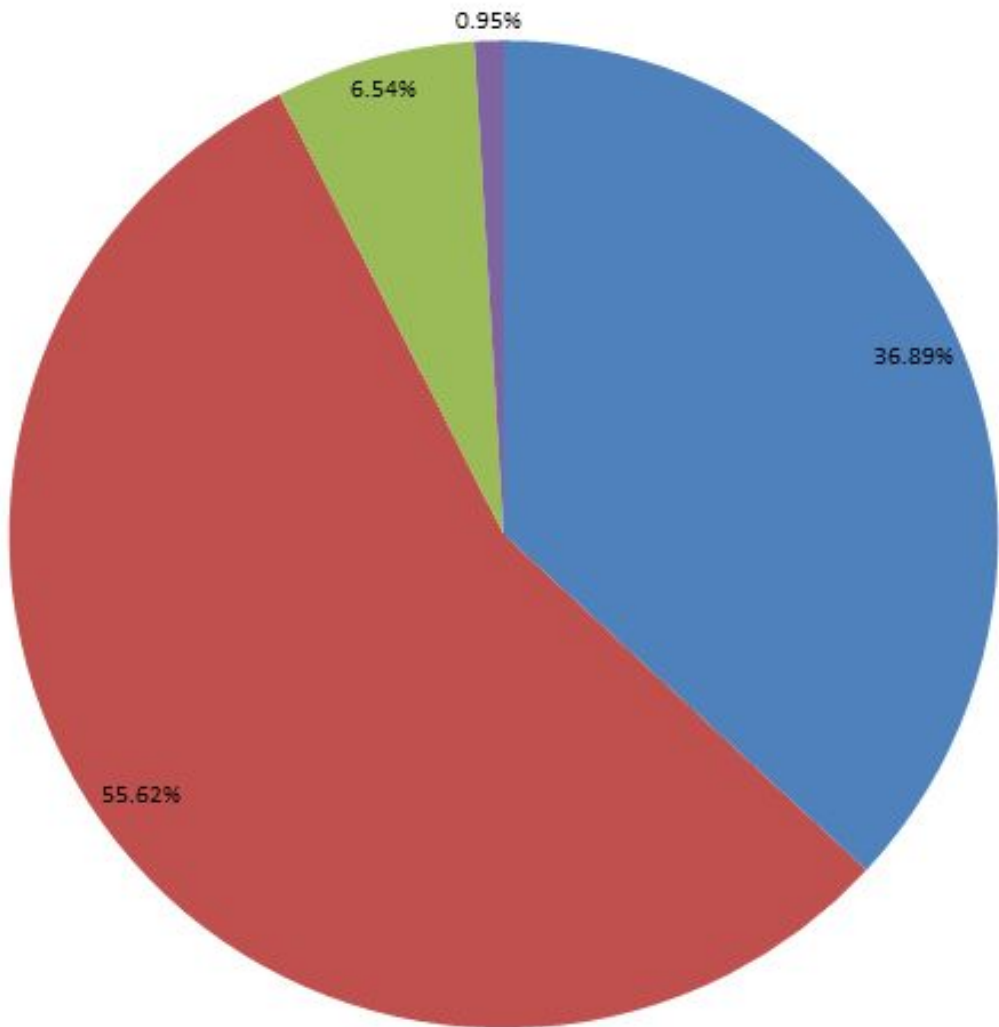

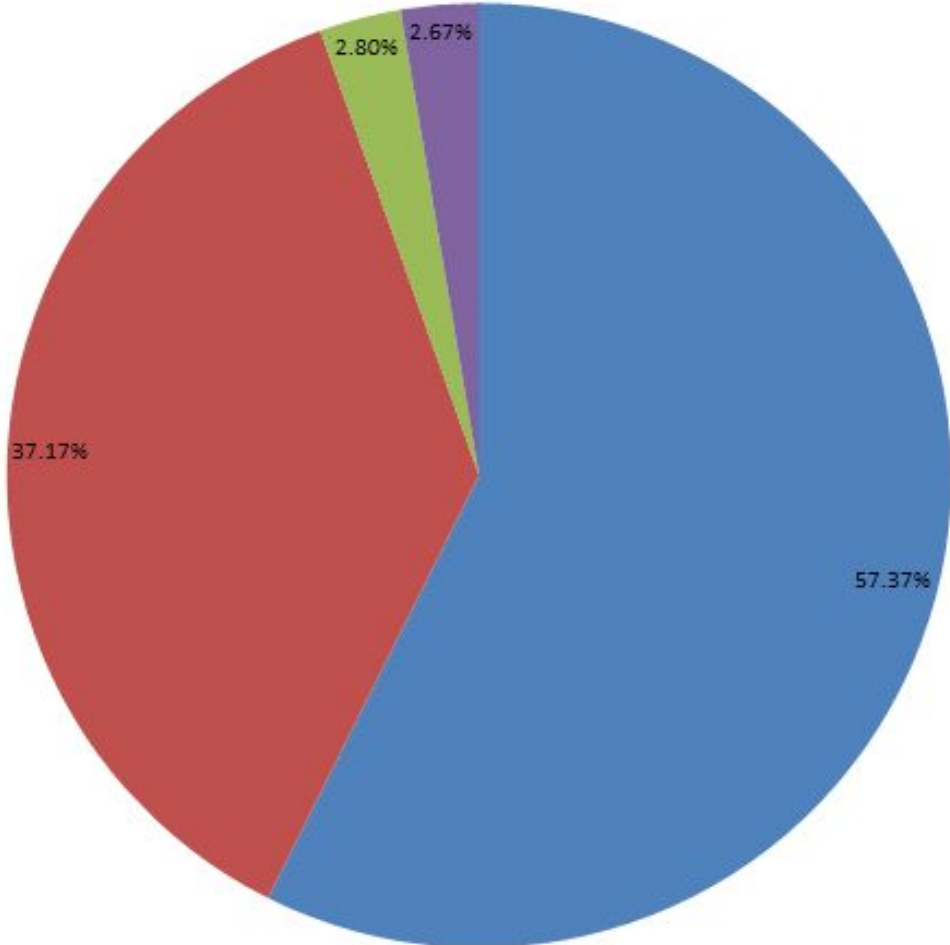

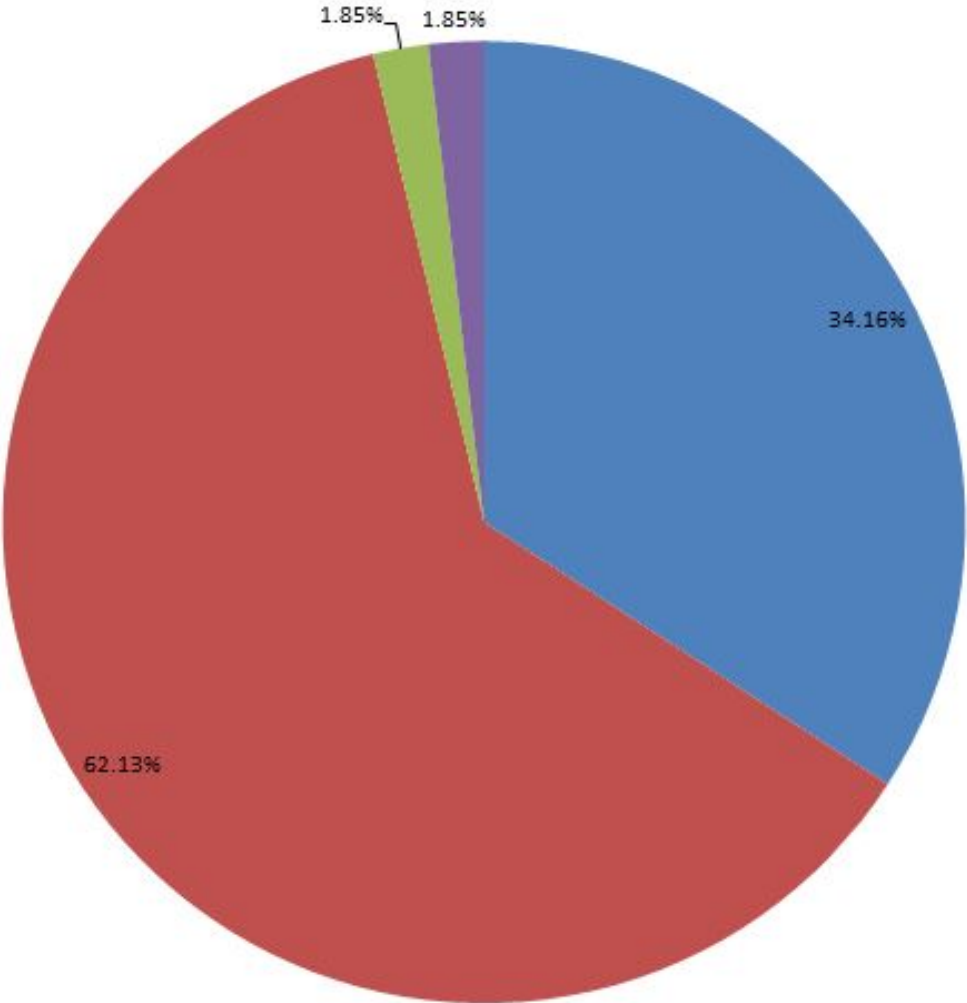

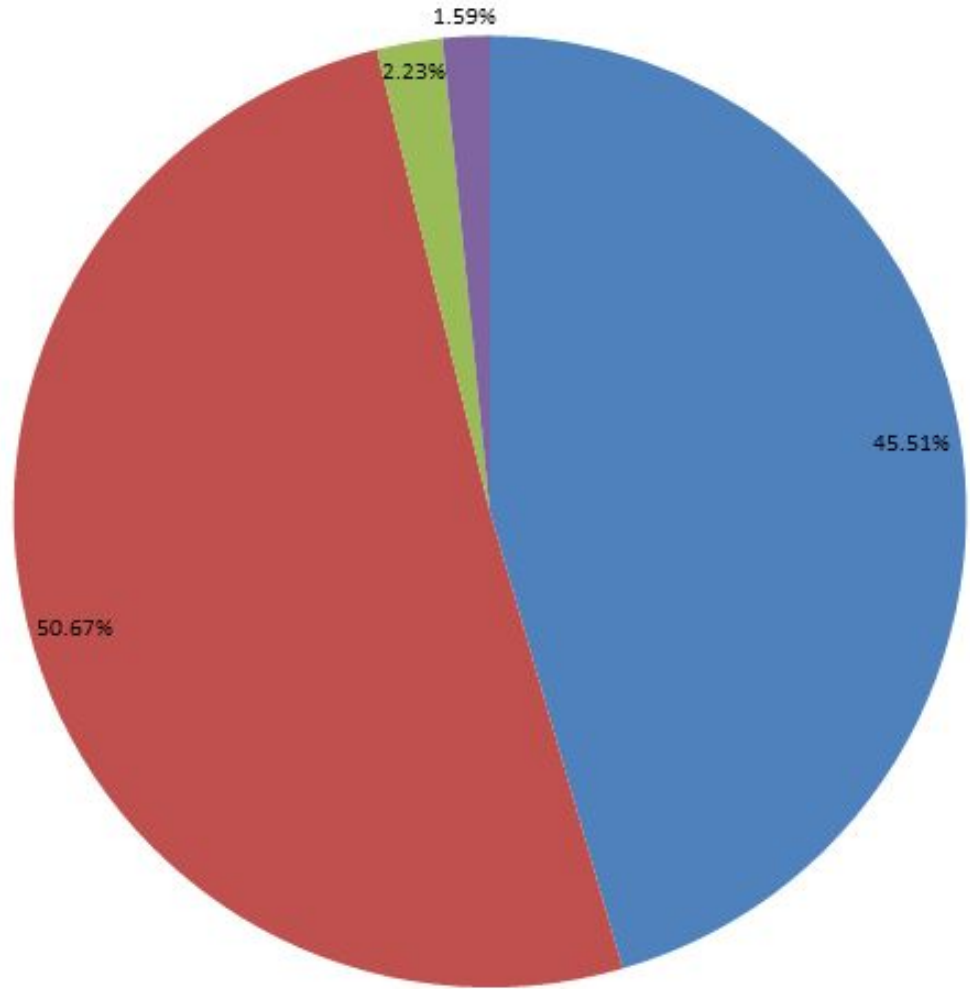

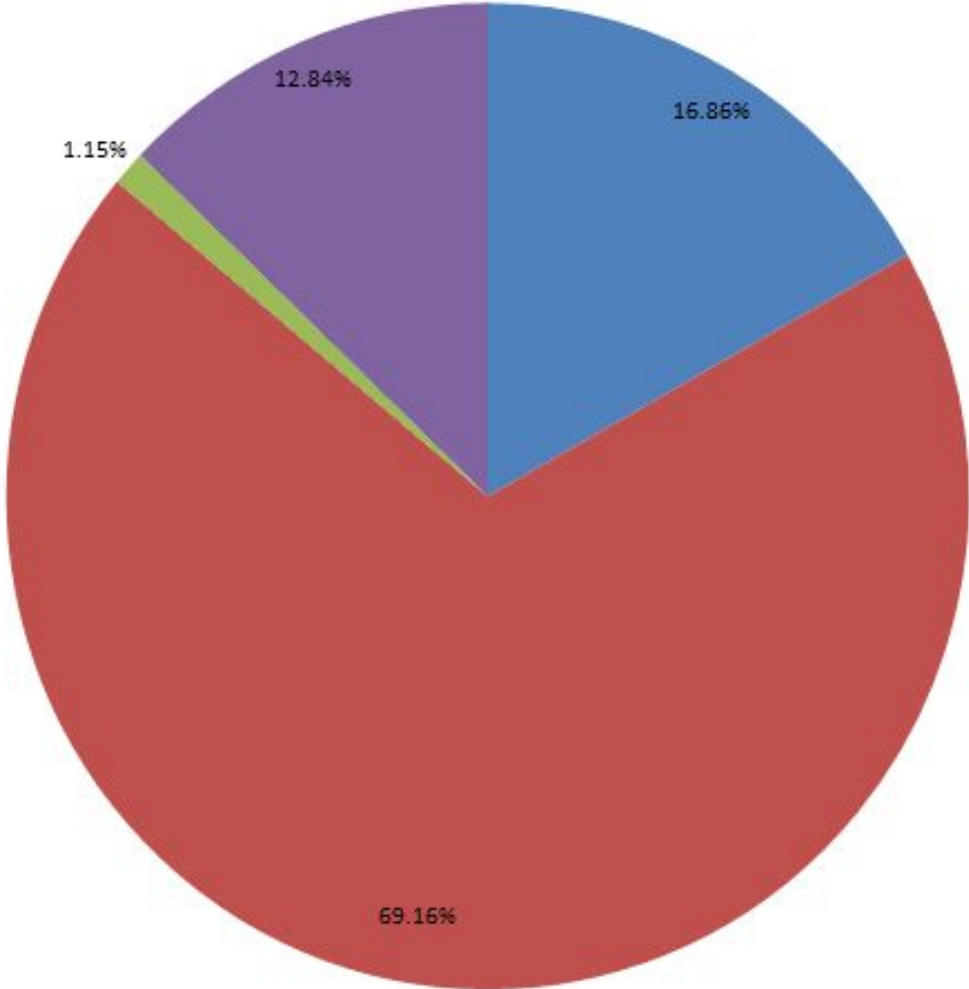

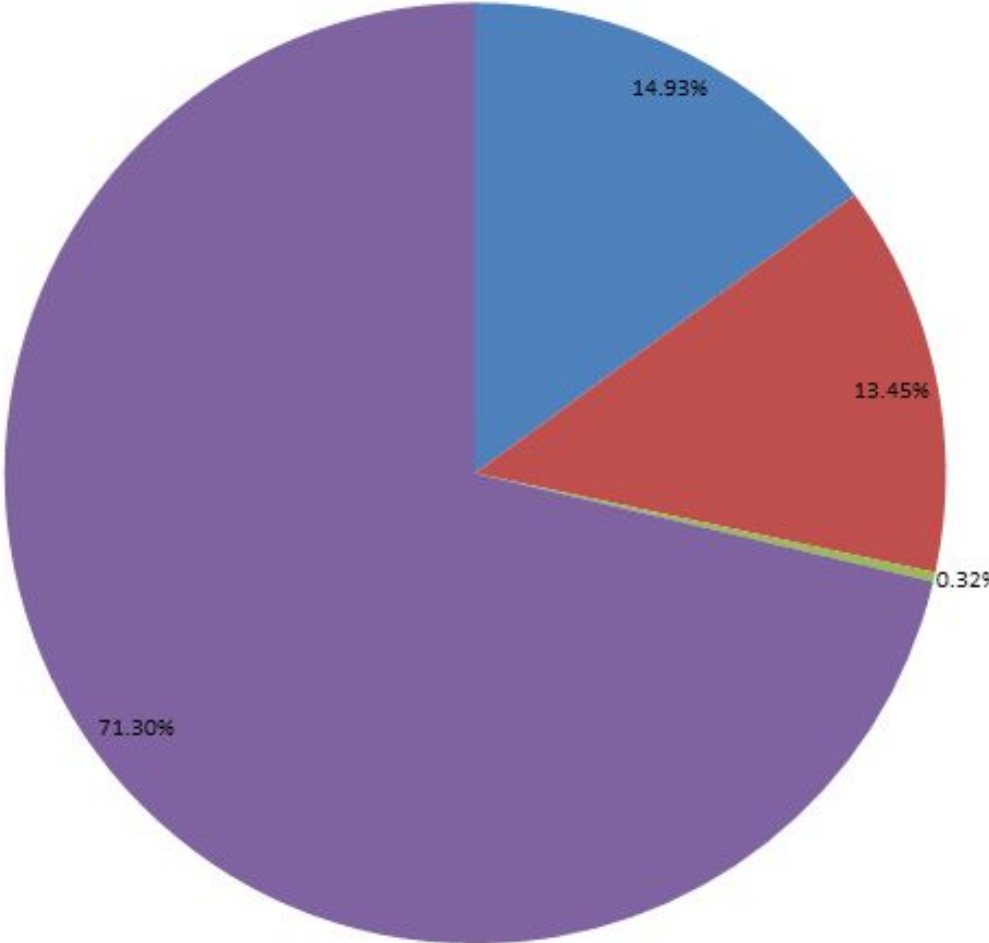

Comment Summary

More than 1,500 comments were shared in the survey

- Concerns about the amount of screen time
- For some, too much work; for others, too little or not challenging
- Desire for more required engagement via live sessions with educators, for SEL and instruction
- Request for more feedback on learning & progress
- Challenges due to lack of in-person support and attention, especially for working parents
- Technology platforms to streamline communication

Next Steps

- Share feedback with administrators and educators to improve current work
- Use feedback to inform planning for 2020-21
 - Purchase more devices to have sufficient for all students for remote learning + in school
 - Technology professional development for the summer
 - Streamline platforms (Google Classroom) preK-12
- Administer survey again in June
