

School Choice Vote

Each year, school committees consider whether their district should be in the school choice program during the upcoming school year. **If they choose not to accept school choice pupils from other districts, they must take a vote prior to June 1 and report the result to DESE.** The results are listed on the DESE website. Districts may also choose to accept new pupils but only in certain grades. If the vote did not specify particular grades, assume that all of the district's grades are open for applications. School choice districts with an asterisk are serving students accepted in past years, but are not enrolling new students.

Sample Vote

In accord with MGL Chapter 76, Section 128, Belmont Public Schools unanimously votes to decline participation in School Choice for the 2021- 2022 school year.
